Birth Outcome Report Data Measure Definitions	

- Caesarean Section (C-Section) delivery of an infant through horizontal or vertical incisions (surgical cuts) made in the abdomen and uterus
- Nulliparous, Term, Singleton, Vertex (NTSV) C-Section Rate babies born at or beyond 37.0
 weeks gestation to women in their first pregnancy, that are singleton (no twins or beyond)
 and in the vertex presentation (no breech or transverse positions)
- Low Birth Weight less than 2,500g (5 lb, 8 oz)
- Preterm Birth prior to 37 weeks
- Early Breastfeeding Initiation putting infant at the breast less than one hour after birth
- · Induction use of medications or other methods to bring on (induce) labor
- Epidural medication for pain relief during labor and delivery
- Infant admitted to Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) intensive care unit specializing in the care of ill or premature newborn infants
